TUITION ASSISTANCE

We currently have two options for tuition assistance at St. Michael's School. The first option is the Children's Scholarship Fund of Omaha (CSF). This national fund provides money for children to attend parochial and private schools across the country. The CSF requires that you qualify financially and invest \$500 per family in your child's education. Applications are completed online - please see instructions below. If you need help applying, please call school. The CSF has a "kickback" to St. Michael's School, so if you qualify, please apply for this tuition assistance!

Our second option is called the Marguerite Rose Grant. This is a local grant that was set up to meet tuition needs of students specifically at St. Michael's School. This grant also asks for a \$500/family investment. This grant has sufficient funds to support many students for years to come! This grant does not have to be repaid. The Marguerite Rose Grant application is enclosed.

Children's Scholarship Fund of Omaha APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Every year the Children's Scholarship Fund (CSF) of Omaha provides students an opportunity to qualify for scholarship money that helps with school tuition. Please check your **2020** tax forms to determine if you are eligible for this scholarship by comparing your "adjusted gross income" to the chart below. Receiving this scholarship not only helps you pay tuition, but it may also provide additional funds for St. Michael's School!

All CSF applications must be completed online and **2020** tax forms either uploaded or mailed to Children's Scholarship Fund in Omaha. The process begins at this address:

***DUE DATE:** CSF scholarship applications are due by **APRIL 30th**. Please allow time to ensure that you have properly submitted all paperwork as the Omaha deadline is May 7. The earlier you can submit your information, the better.
